2. Find an article about an industry that is “hot”. Find some companies and their ticker symbols that are in that industry.

4. Find an article about a new product a company is advertising. How will this affect the company’s stock?
5. Research an article about interest rates. Are they going up? Or down? How will this affect the stock market?
6. Look for a news article that tells about an event that might affect what people are buying. Will they buy more? Will they buy less? How will this affect the stock prices?
7. Research for an article about a company that is expanding globally. How will this affect the stock of the company?
8. Find an article about a company that is experiencing bad times. What is the cause of their problems? How will this affect the company stock. Track the stock price for 4 weeks.
